

PAPER PLATE CROWNS

Materials

Paper plate

Paint, or markers, or crayons

Paint brushes

Scissors

White glue

Things to decorate your crown with: buttons, stickers, sequins, plastic gems, tissue paper, ribbons, foam or fabric shapes, glitter glue, pom poms, etc.







Directions

Step 1: Fold the paper plate in half

Step 2: Cut it like a pizza, but not all the way through, up to the ruffle edges of the plate. Open up and make the last two cuts.

Step 3: Decorate the crown

Step 4: Fold the crown points up and wear your crown!

Literacy Game: SPOT and TELL

Materials

Flashlights

Dark-colored marker

Scissors

Several pieces of paper

Painter's tape

Photos





Directions

Prepare the materials when child is not present—it is a surprise!

Cut 5 pieces of paper in half.

Write large letters on half-size pieces of paper

Tape letters all around on the walls of the room

Close the blinds or wait until dusk

Invite the child to play Spot and Tell game with the flashlight Ask the child to point to the letter with the flashlight and name it

You can write number or sight words instead of letters!
