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FAIRY TALE MATH CASTLE

Materials

Several pieces of paper in different colors

Large piece of paper

Glue stick

Markers, crayons, or pencils

Scissors



Directions

Cut many different shapes such as triangles, circles, squares, diamonds, and ovals from the colored paper. Build a castle by arranging them on the larger piece of paper, glue the shapes down, and decorate.

Follow-up activity:

Kids can do their own writing, or just practice writing the numbers in on the lines.

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Inquiry Challenge: HOW WILL YOU BUILD A BEANSTALK?

Materials

Picture of a castle (or Fairy Tale Math Castle)

(Dragonflies can use the castle they made with Miss Kasia)

Tape

Blocks, Legos, etc.



Directions

Attach the picture of the castle to a wall, at whatever height you want. Ask your child to design and build a “beanstalk” to help them reach the castle like in *Jack and the Beanstalk*. They can use Legos, blocks... whatever they think is best!
