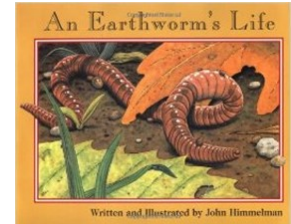

### ART ACTIVITY: Dirt Paint

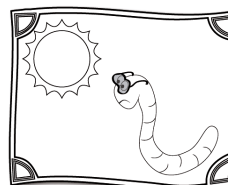
Mix together:

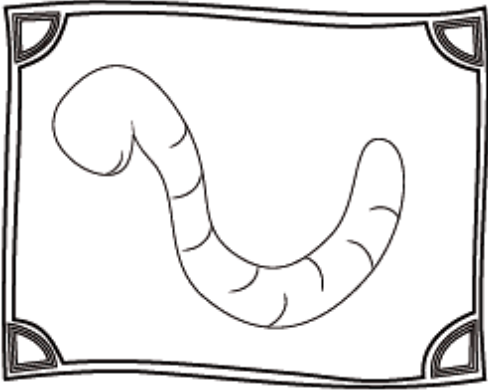
# Another Amazing Science Experiment at Bellevue Discovery Preschool!

<b>My Name</b>	
<b>Our Question</b>	Do worms like an environment <u>that</u> is light or dark?
<b>My Hypotheses</b>	____ I think worms like a <b>light</b> environment ____ I think worms like a <b>dark</b> environment
<b>Our Experiment</b> 	Instructions: <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Find a live earthworm</li><li>2. Line a cookie tray with wet paper towels (because we learned before that worms like a wet environment)</li><li>3. Place another tray over one side of the cookie tray ("the dark side") and leave the other side open ("the light side" - you can make it even brighter with a flashlight)</li><li>4. Put a worm on the light side, but near the middle of the tray</li><li>5. Observe what happens</li></ol>

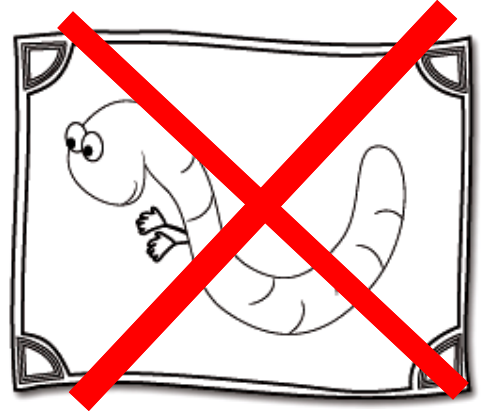

Cut on the lines tape your book together in any order you want!

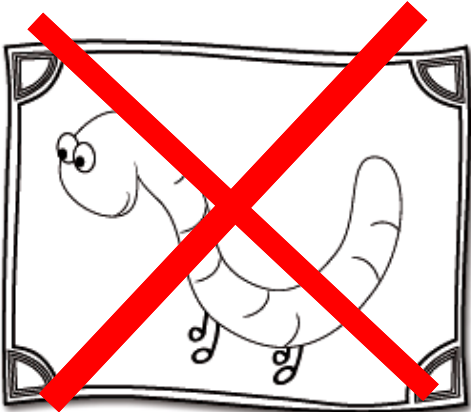
Worms have no eyes.



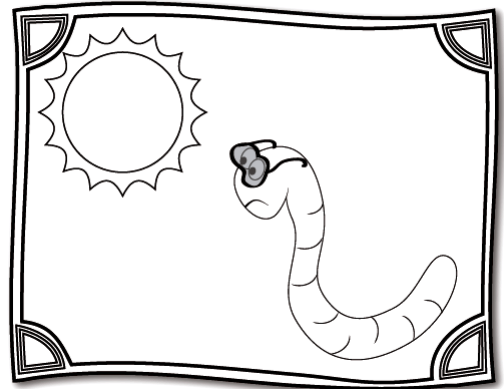
Worms have no arms.
