Hands-on Drama Activity:

Planting a Field of Tulips

"Children appreciate getting outdoors and pretend play."
~Recommended by Miss Rimi~

- Pretend that you have a big farm, with a field ready to plant
- Act like a farmer
- Pretend to make lot of little holes in the field
- Pretend to put seeds into the holes and cover the holes with dirt
- Pretend to water the seeds
- Pretend you have to wait for a few weeks, doing other farm chores and checking on your field every now and then
- Pretend that lot of tulips have bloomed: they are red, yellow, pink and orange
- Pretend to organize a big tulip festival
- Pretend a lot of people come to your festival to see the tulips



Science Activity: From Seed to Plant

Instructions:

1. Place a damp, folded paper towel into a zip lock bag.
 2. Insert 5 staples about half way up the bag. This will keep the beans in the right place so that there's room to watch the roots grow.
 3. Place a few beans into the bag.
 4. Tape the bag onto a wall or window. Add water as needed to keep the paper towel damp.
 5. Watch what happens!
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You could use any seeds if you don't have a bag of dried beans at home. At the preschool we use dried lima beans.
